Important ATD Membership Updates: Price Changes Coming in 2024!

ATD's Professional and Professional Plus membership rates will be increasing for the general membership population in January 2024, including our Power Member rates. This change reflects ATD's continued investment in new and meaningful benefits at increased cost, including the addition of digital access to the Talent Development Body of Knowledge (TDBoK) as a membership benefit. While our membership rates will be increasing in January for the general membership population, chapter leaders will continue to enjoy a significantly reduced membership rate of \$199 with an automatic upgrade to Professional Plus benefits for an additional year to allow chapters to plan for these changes in their annual budgeting process. Starting in 2025, chapter leader membership rates will increase from \$199 to \$219.

Between now and January 5, 2024, ATD will be running a "Lock in Your Rate" campaign to allow current and new members to join/renew at the current rates for up to three years. Chapter leaders have the option to lock in their Professional Plus membership at the current rate for up to three years if planning to continue their board service.
