The Talent Development Executive Confidence Index is ATD's quarterly assessment of talent development executives' six-month expectations for the talent development function.

Expectations are measured on a 100-point scale, where a higher score equals more positive expectations.






The Current Score

Historic High: 69.9 (Q4 2013) Historic Low: 55.1 (Q1 2009)




Key Indicators


Talent Development Funding

During the next six months, do you expect your organization's talent development funding to change?






Trending Technologies
